<p>Consent can be withdrawn at any time by the person who gave it or by any of their close relatives survivors in written form at the operator's address or through a responsible person. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. The operator, after the purpose has been fulfilled, shall ensure the disposal of personal data without undue delay, unless a special law does not require otherwise. The operator will ensure an adequate level of personal data protection. The operator declares that it will process personal data only in accordance with good morals and will act in a way that does not contradict the law on protection of personal data or other generally binding legal regulations.</p>

Your rights in the protection of personal data

The Right to access - you have the right to provide a copy of the personal data we hold about you, as well as information on how we use your personal data. In most cases, they will be provided in written document form, unless you request another way of providing them. If you requested the provision of this information by electronic means, it will be provided to you electronically, if technically possible.

The Right to rectification - we take reasonable steps to ensure accuracy, completeness and timeliness information we have about you. If you think that the data we have is inaccurate, incomplete or out of date, please do not hesitate to ask us to correct this information, update or supplement.

The Right to erasure (to be forgotten) - you have the right to ask us to delete your personal data, for example, if the personal data we have obtained about you is no longer necessary for fulfillment of original purpose of processing. However, your right needs to be assessed from the point of view of all relevant circumstances. For example, we may have certain legal and regulatory obligations that means we will not be able to comply with your request.

The Right to restriction of processing - in certain circumstances you are entitled to ask us to stop using your personal data. These are, for example, cases where you believe that personal data we have about you, they may be inaccurate or when you think that we no longer need to use your personal data.

The Right to data portability - under certain circumstances, you have the right to ask us to transfer the personal data you have provided to us to another third party of your choice. However, the right to portability only applies to personal data that we have obtained from you on the basis of consent or on the basis of a contract to which you are a party.

The Right to object - you have the right to object to data processing based on our legitimate interests. In the event that we do not have a compelling legitimate reason for processing and you file an objection, we will not process your personal data further.

The right to submit a proposal to initiate proceedings on the protection of personal data - if you believe that your personal data is being processed unfairly or illegally, you can file a complaint to the supervisory authority, which is the Personal Data Protection Office of the Slovak Republic, Hraničná 12, 820 07 Bratislava 27; Tel.
