

Personal data protection policy

Creative center Nitra (city of Nitra) (hereinafter "Operator") collects, processes and uses personal data in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27/04/2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on free movement such data and with Act no. 18/2018 Coll. about the protection of personal data and does everything necessary so as to ensure compliance with these legal regulations.

The operator will process personal data only for the the purposes that were obtained. The operator declares that he will process personal data only in accordance with good manners and will act in a way that does not contradict the law on personal data protection or others in generalbinding legal regulations and will not circumvent these regulations. Operator upon fulfillment of purpose of processing personal data, without undue delay will ensure the liquidation of personal data unless otherwise required by special law.

The operator ensures an adequate level of protection of personal data, also protects processed personal data against damage, destruction, loss, change, access, unauthorized access, disclosure, as well as, against making them available or public and against other unlawful methods of processing and for this purpose accepted and accepts adequate security measures corresponding to the method of personal data processing.

The operator will process personal data in accordance with the rights of the person concerned. Affected person has the right to obtain confirmation from the operator as to whether his or her personal data is being processed. If the operator processes such personal data, the person concerned has the right to obtain access to this personal data and information about:

- the purpose of processing personal data,
- categories of processed personal data,
- period of storage of personal data; if this is not possible, information on the criteria for its determination,

- the identification of the recipient or the category of recipient to whom the personal data was or should be provided, especially about a recipient in a third country or an international organization, if it is possible,
- the right to request from the operator the correction of personal data relating the person concerned, their deletion or restriction of their processing, or the right to object to the processing of personal data
 - right to file a motion to initiate proceedings,
 - sources of personal data, if the personal data were not obtained from the data subject,
 - the existence of automated individual decision-making, including profiling.

The data subject has the right to obtain from the operator without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her. Taking into account the purposes of the processing, the data subject has the right to have incomplete personal data completed

The affected person has the right to have the operator delete personal data concerning her without undue delay, if:

- personal data are no longer necessary for the purpose for which they were obtained or otherwise processed,
- the person concerned revokes the consent on the basis of which the processing of personal data is carried out, and there is no other legal basis for processing personal data. Withdrawal of consent has no effect on the legality of processing based on consent before its withdrawal,
- the person concerned objects to the processing of personal data and there are no valid reasons for processing personal data
 - personal data is processed illegally.

The affected person has the right to limit the processing of his or her personal data by the operator if:

- the person concerned objects to the correctness of the personal data, during the enabling period to verify the correctness of personal data by the operator,
- the processing of personal data is illegal and the data subject objects to the deletion of personal data and requests a restriction of its use instead,
- the operator no longer needs personal data for the purpose of processing personal data, but
 - the person concerned needs them to assert a legal claim, or
 - the person concerned objects to the processing of personal data.

The person concerned has the right to obtain personal data that concern him or her and which he or she has provided to the operator, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and has the right to transfer this personal data to another operator, if technically possible. The right of portability does not apply to the processing of personal data necessary to fulfill the task implemented in the public interest or in the exercise of public authority entrusted to the operator.

The person concerned has the right to object to the processing of his or her personal data for reasons related to its specific situation carried out within the legitimate interest of the operator, including profiling based on these regulations. The operator may not further process personal data, if it does not prove the necessary legitimate interests for the processing of personal data, which prevail over the rights or interests of the person concerned, or reasons for the application of legal claim.

The person concerned has the right to object to the processing of personal data concerning him or her for the purpose of direct marketing, including profiling to the extent that it is related to direct marketing. If the data subject objects to the processing of personal data for the purpose of direct marketing, the operator may not further process personal data for the purpose of direct marketing.

The person concerned has the right not to be affected by the decision which is based exclusively on the automated processing of personal data, including profiling, and which has legal effects that relate to it or similarly significantly affect it, unless it doesn't concern personal data necessary for the conclusion of the contract or the fulfillment of the contract between the affected person and operator.

The affected person has the right to submit a request for an investigation pursuant to §100 of Act No.: 18/2018 Coll. about personal data protection if he or she suspects that his or her personal data is being handled in an illegal manner or by processing his or her personal data or breaching security of processing, his or her rights were violated.

The operator or intermediary may under the conditions established by special regulation or international treaty to which the Slovak Republic is bound, limit the scope of obligations and rights if such limitation is established in order to ensure:

- the security of the Slovak Republic,
- the defense of the Slovak Republic,
- public order,
- performance of tasks for the purposes of criminal proceedings,
- other important goals of general public interest of the European Union or the Slovak Republic, especially the subject of important economic interest or important financial interest

of the European Union or the Slovak Republic, including monetary, budgetary and tax affairs, public health or social security,

- protection of the independence of the judiciary and judicial proceedings,
- preventing violations of ethics in regulated professions or regulated professional areas activities,
- monitoring function, control function or regulatory function associated with public performance power
- protection of the rights of the affected person or other persons,
- exercising a legal claim,
- economic mobilization.

The affected person has the right to defend his or her rights through a responsible person or by submitting a request for an investigation, a complaint, to the supervisory authority, in Slovakia, The Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic in accordance with §100 of Act No.: 18/2018 Coll.
